RESOLUTION NO. 2018-18

WHEREAS, the owner of the lands abutting that certain portion of Cumberland Drive in Andalusia, Alabama according to the map and plat of said addition recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Covington County, Alabama, in Plat Book 3, page 40 & 43, desire to vacate said portion of the unpaved street (Cumberland Drive) lying between Lots 1 thru 12 of Meadowbrook Subdivision, pursuant to Section 19-4N-16E of Code of Alabama, (1975, as amended); and

WHEREAS, said unpaved street to be vacated is within the limits of the City of Andalusia, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, said unpaved street has never been opened or used by any other property owners for access, and

WHEREAS, the vacation of said street shall not deprive any other property owner of any rights of ingress and regress.
