ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDALUSIA,
ALABAMA:**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Andalusia, Alabama, desires to improve the quality of life for all of its citizens and the residents of surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance of the City of Andalusia, Alabama, has not been updated since 2009; and

WHEREAS, various definitions and language are now required by FEMA for the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs's Office of Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Andalusia finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Andalusia to encourage responsible development that will minimize flood damage and that the attached ordinance will assist in accomplishing the goal of promoting the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizenry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Andalusia, Alabama that Ordinance 2009-06 is repealed and that in its place the attached ordinance be adopted and that the attached ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
