**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Andalusia, Alabama, as follows:

That Joe Nix received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember, District One, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025.

That Presley Boswell and Greg Palmer each received the same number of votes cast for the office of Councilmember, District Four, and that, according to the Code of Alabama “the tie shall be decided by the municipal governing body” and that “[i]f the municipal governing body fails to break the tie, the elected candidate shall be decided by lot by the judge of probate.”
